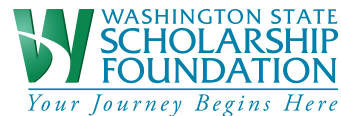


Our History:

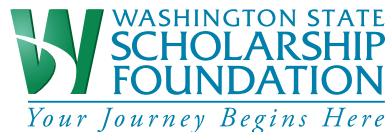


Our Mission:

The Washington State Scholarship Foundation's (WSSF) mission is to provide educational opportunities through scholarships to those in financial need.

WSSF is a team of passionate volunteers who believe that every person, regardless of age, sex, or ethnicity deserves the chance to improve their lives through vocational training or post-secondary education.

The goal for each year is to award 95% of all donations to the students. The dedicated staff of volunteers believes that these gifts should be granted to those who really need them.



Guidelines:

Financial need is the primary criteria for determining who will receive a scholarship. All applicants must have a high school, public or private education, signified by a high school diploma or a G E D from a Washington State school. Regardless of age, all applicants must be first time freshman. This means that a person can be 18 or 80 and receive a Foundation scholarship, as long as this is their first year in school.

School can be defined as a university, community college or vocational school. Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) will be given to recipients entering four year post-secondary institutions. One thousand dollars (\$1,000) will be awarded for community colleges, voc-tech schools or other accredited institutions.
